Investment philosophy and process

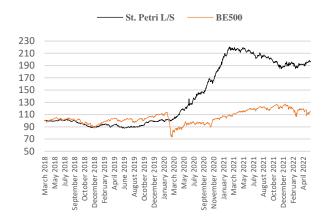
WEALTH INVEST AKL St. Petri L/S I is a long/short thematic equity fund managed by St. Petri Capital. The investment process is centered on identifying transformative forces of change that will have an impact on sectors and companies' cash flows and reshape economies and industries over the long term. The fund is managed by pioneers of the thematic investment process with an unchanged process since the mid 1990s. The team has specialized in using operational investment themes to identify disrupters and disrupted companies and buying and shorting mispriced companies where fundamental tail- or headwinds have not yet been captured and discovered by the market. The decision-making process is based on bottom-up fundamental analysis of primarily European small/mid-cap stocks, and the process puts emphasis on agility of decisions. This leads to a portfolio of high conviction positions, although maintaining the possibility to adjust and de-risk quickly. St. Petri believes that superior long-term returns comes from differentiating from the crowd, making non-consensus investments by independent thinking and protecting capital by hedging.
